

## Kings College Guildford – Year 7 Catch Up Funding 2016-17

For the academic year 2016-17 we have received £9667 through catch-up premium.

### Objectives in spending Catch Up Funding

- Narrow the gap between 'Catch Up' students and the rest of the cohort
- Improve levels of progress made by these students
- Develop literacy and numeracy skills for students

<b>Year 7 English Intervention</b> <b>£6556</b>	20 students have worked with an English teacher to improve knowledge and application of SPaG in intervention lessons and core lessons. 15 students have made significant progress as a result of these sessions. The 5 remaining students have made progress but have made less progress. All 5 of these students have additional learning needs.
<b>Year 7 Numeracy intervention</b> <b>£3111</b>	SEND and PP Maths intervention occurred with an HLTA during the Autumn term. This was less impactful as there was not a set programme to follow. Further numeracy intervention has occurred during Module 6 with Year 7. Again, this has been less successful.

### Actions:

- Benchmarking for each year group
- Structured and well researched interventions
- Clear outcomes and correct targeting
- Intervention staff group
- Specific training for intervention staff
- QA the transfer of intervention strategies into lessons

### How will we identify students?

Baseline testing – reading, spelling – all students Year 7-10

- GLS Spelling -30 minute group test for annual testing
- Suffolk Reading Test- in use for whole classes no additional costs now purchased.
- Writing – Year 7 and Year 11 September examinations
- Numeracy Screen - 1:1 screen up to 17 years identifies gaps and measures interventions (SEND)
- Maths – Year 7 and 11 September examinations
- Module 6 Data
